

Mayor's report to Full Council March 2026

This report outlines my activities since the last council meeting on January 22nd, 2026. After a busy festive period, January and February were quieter, largely spent planning the successful Gala Ball on February 21st with 101 guests, raising over £4,000 for the mayor's charities. Final fundraising totals will be determined at the end of my term. Thanks to local businesses for donations and town hall staff Jo, Pippa, and Lisa for their support.

A working party discussed the War Memorial Recreation ground, with online booking systems planned once land transfer from Waverley is finalized; similar systems are coming to Beacon Hill Recreation ground and High Lane. The Beacon Hill group is moving from a 20mph survey to exploring a 30mph limit on the A287, particularly near Beacon Hill Road—a concern for residents due to schoolchildren crossing.

Grovers Gardens has ongoing clearing efforts, supported by councillors and residents, under Projects Manager Christian's guidance.
